22	MS. MACQUESTEN: This is a compliance action against
23	a sole proprietor, Mr. Calvin Tennison. The case was heard on
24	June 12, 2008. During the course of preparing the case, we

learned that $\operatorname{Mr.}$ Tennison is deceased, so we treated the case

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as an orphan well case.

At the hearing, the acting Division counsel asked that we give notice to Bill and Patsy Rich, whose names appeared in the well file, in case they wanted to assert an interest in the wells. The case was held open until July 10 to allow us to give that notice. We gave the notice to Bill and Patsy Rich. We also gave notice to a company called Sisters, LLC. That company's name appeared in the well files as connected to Patsy Rich, so we, in an abundance of caution, notified them as well.

Sisters, LLC, responded with a letter explaining the history of the well transfers after Mr. Tennison's death and stated that another company, Master Energy Resources, Inc., was the current owner of the wells.

I called Master Energy Resources, Inc. They said they intended to take over the wells and become operator of record under the name of Master Energy Resources, LLC. I requested a continuance of this case until today so that they could register their company with the PRC, obtain bonding, and become operator of record. I sent them a copy of the notice of hearing and the letter requesting the continuance until today.

Now, neither Master Energy Resources, LLC nor Master Energy Resources, Inc. appears on the PRC website. They have not obtained bonding and, to my knowledge, they have taken no action to become operator of record for these wells.

I ask that this case be decided and that an order be issued allowing the OCD to plug the wells. Master Energy, in any of its incarnations, can still become operator of record and take over the wells, but having an order in place will pressure them to take action. Also, if we have a compliance order in place, we will be able to require the new operator to enter into an Agreed Compliance Order telling us how they plan to address the compliance issues before they take over the wells.

And also -- for the Examiner's information -- when we started this case, it was with regard to a certain number of wells. Now all of the wells operated by Calvin Tennison are out of compliance.

MR. BROOKS: How many wells is that?

MS. MACQUESTEN: It's relatively small. I can't recall offhand, but I think it's about nine or ten wells.

MR. BROOKS: Thank you.

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MS. MACQUESTEN: You should have a copy of my request for continuance with the notice of hearing showing the attempts to notice Bill and Patsy Rich, Sisters, LLC, and the response we received. I'd like to enter that as an exhibit into the case, and I have marked copies here if you would like them to be an exhibit.

MR. BROOKS: Well, I think we need one for the court reporter. That would be all, assuming it's in the file. I'm
