This is in reference to the Application of Amoco Production Company for salt water disposal at an unorthodox location in Union County, New Mexico (Case 7869).

AmeriGas has no objection to Amoco's request for the above and understands that the maximum injection rate in the Glorieta Zone will be one barrel of water per million cubic feet produced of CO₂. In the event that either the projected injection rate exceeds these limits or another injection well is used closer to AmeriGas' property on the southwest corner of the Bravo Dome Unit, we would object based on possible damage to our potentially productive Leases in the Glorieta Zone.
