- 4. The Pool is subject to the Division's statewide spacing rules, which provide for:
 - (a) 160 acre well units, comprised of a single governmental quarter section;
 - (b) Wells to be located no closer than 660 feet to a quarter section line nor closer than 10 feet to an interior quarter-quarter section line; and
 - (c) One well per well unit.
- 5. Engineering and geologic data from wells in the Pool shows that wells are not capable of draining 160 acres, and more than one well should be drilled on each well unit to produce all reserves.

- 6. Attached as Exhibit A is a plat highlighting (in yellow) the lands, inside and outside the Pool (as expanded), under which mineral ownership is common (except for one small area of the Pool). Due to common mineral ownership in the lands within the Pool (as expanded), well location requirements in the Pool can be relaxed without impairing the correlative rights of mineral owners in the pool.
- 7. Due to topographic conditions in the lands within the Pool (as expanded), well sites at orthodox locations are difficult to obtain. Therefore, relaxing well location requirements will help minimize surface disturbance in the area covered by the Pool.
- 8. As a result of the foregoing, applicant requests that special rules and regulations for the Pool (as expanded) be established, providing for:
 - (a) 160 acre well units, comprised of a single governmental quarter section;
 - (b) Two wells on each well unit, whether they are vertical or horizontal wells, which may be located on any quarter-quarter section in the well unit;
 - (c) Wells to be located no closer than 10 feet to a quarter section line or an interior quarter-quarter section line, subject to the directional drilling provisions of Division Rule 111 (NMAC 19.15.3.111);
 - (d) A buffer zone on the exterior of the lands highlighted on Exhibit A, where wells must be located in accordance with statewide rules; and
 - (e) An administrative procedure for an exception to the well density provisions of the special pool rules.
- 9. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation, the prevention of waste, and the protection of correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division grant the relief requested above.


