MOTION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION TO DISMISS CASE NO. 14110

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) moves to dismiss Case No. 14110 for the following reasons:

- 1. On March 13, 2008 the OCD filed an application for hearing in Case 14110, alleging that Quannah, Inc. (Quannah) had disposed of produced water into a private disposal system without the operator's approval.
 - 2. Case 14110 was heard on April 17, 2008.
- 3. On August 7, 2008 the Division issued Order No. R-12977 finding that Quannah had disposed of produced water into a private disposal system without the operator's approval. The order assessed a penalty of \$1,000, and suspended Quannah's authority to transport oilfield waste for a period of six months, running from August 15, 2008 to February 14, 2009.
 - 4. Quannah requested de novo review in Case 14110.
- 5. According to representations made by Quannah's director and owner, Louis Edgett, Quannah no longer operates as a transporter of oilfield waste.

Case 14110 Motion to Dismiss Page 1 of 2 6. Quannah did not pay the \$1,000 penalty assessed in Case 14110, so there is no penalty to be returned to Quannah if the case is dismissed.

For the foregoing reasons, the OCD respectfully requests that Case 14110 be dismissed.
