

CASE 7864: Application of Inexco Oil Company for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Strawn formation underlying the W/2 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at an unorthodox location 1650 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line of Section 13. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.

CASE 7865: Application of Julian Ard for a non-standard proration unit or, in the alternative, compulsory pooling, Chaves County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks approval of a 160-acre non-standard proration unit in the Atoka formation comprising the SE/4 of Section 14, Township 8 South, Range 27 East or, in the alternative, seeks approval to pool all mineral interests in the Atoka formation underlying the E/2 of Section 14, Township 8 South, Range 27 East, to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard location thereon. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well.

Application of Clements Energy Company for an amendment to Order No. R-2359, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an amendment to Division Order No. R-2359 deleting the requirement that wells be located in the NE/4 or SW/4 of any governmental section in the East Saunders-Permo Pennsylvanian Pool so that all wells may be drilled 150 feet from the center of any quarter-quarter section. Applicant also seeks the promulgation of an administrative procedure for the approval of unorthodox well locations.

CASE 7866: Application of Mobil Producing Texas & New Mexico, Inc. for a waterflood expansion, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks authority to expand its Bridges-State Waterflood Project by drilling four water injection wells at unorthodox locations as follows:

WELL A - 2,340 feet from the North line and 2,630 feet from the West line of Section 25.

WELL B - 2,630 feet from the North line and 10 feet from the East line of Section 26

WELL C - 10 feet from the South line and 1,250 feet from the East line of Section 26

WELL D - 10 feet from the South line and 2,630 feet from the East line of Section 26

All in Township 17 South, Range 34 East.

Application of Joseph I. O'Neill, Jr. for discovery designation, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks the designation of a new discovery producing horizon in the Scharb-Bone Springs Field for its Ora Jackson Wells Nos. 1 and 2 located, respectively, in the NW/4 SW/4 and the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 5, Township 19 South, Range 35 East.
