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1 MR. BROOKS: Good morning, ladies and gentlemen. 2 This is Docket No. 35-08, Oil Conservation Division. I'm David 3 Brooks, presiding Examiner. Terry Warnell is assisting as Technical Examiner, and the Chief Engineer had indicated he's 4 5 going to participate, and he is here this morning. 6 Let's first call the continuances and dismissals, 7 then we're going to take things out of order. So we'll begin 8 with the continuance and dismissals, as usual. 9 On the first page, Case No. 14189 is continued to 10 October 30th. 11 On the third page, Case No. 14024 is dismissed. 12 Case No. 14147 is continued to November the 13th. 13 Case No. 14148 is continued to November the 13th. 1.4 On the fourth page, Case No. 14191 is dismissed. 15 On the fifth page, Case No. 14192 is continued to 16 November the 13th; however, there is a motion hearing in that 17 case this morning. 18 . On the sixth page, Case No. 14198 is dismissed. 19 The presumed order of proceeding will be as 20 follows -- and let me know if there are any objections or 21 preferences to do things otherwise. 22 We will begin with the motion hearing in Case 23 No. 14192. Following that hearing, we will -- oh, I forgot to 24 ask if there any continuances or dismissals. 25 Case No. 14190; is there anyone here on that case?

We call 14190. It's the Application of -- I'm sorry, no, not 1 2 14190. I'm calling Case No. 14162, the Application for 3 Merrion Oil and Gas Corp. for Compulsory Pooling, San Juan 4 County, New Mexico. Is there any appearance in that case? 5 6 Okay, we had gotten a motion for continuance in that case to November 13th, so that case will be continued to 7 November 13th. 8 9 Any other continuances or dismissals? Okay, we will begin this morning with Case No. 14192. 10 11 That will be followed by Case No. 14193 and the following cases 12 to the end of the docket of Case No. 14197. 13 Then we will go back and start at the beginning of 14 the docket with Case No. 14129, and then we will take Case 15 No. 14190. And we will conclude the evening with Case 16 No. 14186, unless there are any objections to that order of 17 proceeding. 18 Mr. Feldewert? MR. FELDEWERT: Just a question, Mr. Examiner. Since 19 20 you're taking 14186 last, is it safe to assume that we can be 21 dismissed until 1 o'clock? 22 MR. BROOKS: Well, let me ask the people who are here 23 involved. I understood one of the Division's cases was going 24 to be particularly long, and I thought it was 14186. But 25 there's also 14129 that's also contested, so which one is the

1 longer one of the two? MS. ALTOMARE: My understanding is that it was ours 2 3 that was the longer one. MR. BROOKS: That's which one? 4 MS. ALTOMARE: 14186. 5 MR. BROOKS: That was my understanding, also. How 6 long will it take, do you think? 7 8 MR. FELDEWERT: 14186? MR. BROOKS: Yeah. 9 10 MR. FELDEWERT: Mr. Examiner, I looked at the pre-hearing statement and they have, it looks like three hours 11 12 of testimony designated. 13 MR. BROOKS: That's from both sides, or from one 14 side? 15 MS. ALTOMARE: I believe for both sides. MR. FELDEWERT: So I guess --16 17 MR. BROOKS: Okay. We'll set that one over to 1:15, 18 then. MR. FELDEWERT: Okay. 19 MR. BROOKS: And there's no reason you all should sit 20 here the whole time, so you can come back at 1:15. 21 Okay. This Targa case -- yes? Did somebody have 22 23 something to say over here? The Division people that are not going to be needed 24 until Case No. 14129 may be excused at this time, and I will 25
