### ORDER OF THE DIVISION

#### BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on May 25, 1983, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard Stamets.

NOW, on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of June, 1983, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Yates Petroleum Corporation, seeks an exception to Rule 104.C.I to permit applicant to develop its Eagle Creek San Andres Pool with five wells on each 40-acre tract in a five-spot pattern.
- (3) The subject wells are located on portions of the following lands in Eddy County, New Mexico:

# Township 17 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M.

Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28

(4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the oil in the subject pool, will result in the recovery -2-Case No. 7871 Order No. R-

of oil that would otherwise not be recovered, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That an exception to Rule 104.C.I is hereby approved, and applicant may develop its Eagle Creek San Andres Pool with five wells on each 40-acre tract, in a five-spot pattern; provided that one of such five wells shall be located within 100 feet of the center of each governmental quarter-quarter.
- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
