APPLICATION

Edge Petroleum Operating Company, Inc. applies for an order (i) expanding the horizontal limits of the Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, or in the alternative (ii) approving a non-standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Northeast Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool comprised of the SW¼NW¼ of Section 25, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and approving an unorthodox oil well location in said well unit. In support thereof, applicant states:

- 1. Applicant is the operator of the South Lovington 25 Well No. 1, located 1977 feet from the north line and 330 feet from the west line of Section 25.
- 2. Applicant drilled the South Lovington 25 Well No. 1 to a depth sufficient to test the Devonian formation (Wildcat Devonian), and the SW¼NW¼ of Section 25 was dedicated to the well. The well was unsuccessful in the Devonian formation, but it was completed uphole in the Strawn (Upper Pennsylvanian) formation.
- 3. There are two Upper Pennsylvanian pools within one mile of the South Lovington 25 Well No. 1: (a) the Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, which is developed on statewide rules providing for 40 acre spacing and wells to be located no closer than 330 feet to a quarter-quarter section line; and (b) the Northeast Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, which under



Order No. R-3816, as amended, is developed on 80 acre spacing with wells to be located within 150 feet of the center of a quarter-quarter section.

- 4. The Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool includes the SW¼ of adjoining Section 23, while the Northeast Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool includes, among other acreage, the E½ of adjoining Section 24.
- 5. The Division's Hobbs District Office has placed the well in the Northeast Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, although the operator requested that it be placed in the Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool.
- 6. Applicant requests that the horizontal limits of the Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool be expanded to include the NW¼ of Section 25. This will allow a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit to be dedicated to the South Lovington 25 Well No. 1, which is at an orthodox oil well location.
- 7. In the alternative, applicant requests approval of a non-standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit in the Northeast Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, comprised of the SW¼NW¼ of Section 25. The non-standard unit will be dedicated to the South Lovington 25 Well No. 1, located at an unorthodox oil well location in said pool. Applicant also requests approval of the unorthodox location.
- 8. Applicant's request is based on the following factors: (a) the well nearest the South Lovington 25 Well No. 1 which produced from the Upper Pennsylvanian formation was in the Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool, in the SW¼ of Section 23; (b) pressure and flow data gathered by applicant on the South Lovington 25 Well No. 1 indicates a limited reservoir, which supports it being developed on 40 acre spacing; (c) geology indicates that the Strawn reservoir in the South Lovington 25 Well No. 1 is separate from the Strawn reservoir in the Northeast

Lovington-Upper Pennsylvanian Pool; and (d) applicant drilled the South Lovington 25 Well No.

1 on a 40 acre basis, and re-spacing the well will adversely affect existing equities in the well.

9. Approval of this application will prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order approving the relief requested above.
