This is the Application of COG Operating, LLC for Designation of a Non-Standard Spacing Unit for Compulsory Pooling, Chaves County, New Mexico. I thought this was scheduled for October 13th, and it was continued to today to supply additional information.

MR. HALL: Mr. Examiner, Scott Hall, Montgomery and Andrews, Santa Fe, appearing on behalf of COG Operating, LLC.

MR. EZEANYIM: Any other appearances?

MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe, representing Cimarex Energy Company.

MR. EZEANYIM: Any witnesses?

MR. HALL: No witnesses.

So we had our witness at that hearing, a petroleum engineer, Jessie Lawson, provide us with a synopsis of the drilling profile which I'll provide to you as Exhibit 20.

In addition to that, Mr. Examiner, there's contained in the well file the Inteq Planned Wellpath report. I'll give a copy of that to Mr. Warnell. It also shows that same

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information for the drilling profile. 1 Mr. Brooks also asked that we supplement the record 2 with the original of the certified notice, which we have here 3 today for both cases, and actually, all of the COG cases that 4 were on the docket for last week since we mailed multiple 5 notices in one envelope to the several parties. So I'll offer 6 7 those for the record. MR. EZEANYIM: Okav. 9 MR. HALL: That's all we have, Mr. Examiner. 10 MR. EZEANYIM: Anything, Mr. Bruce? MR. BRUCE: No, I have nothing. The case was heard 11 12 and I've entered an appearances. And I did request that these 13 matters be continued because Cimarex Energy has counter -- or 14 has competing cases set for December 4th.
