We seek to pool everybody, except Chesapeake 20 Α. and Mewbourne Oil Company, which would commence with 21 22 Cathy J. Jones and end with Georgia E. Kotlinski. Now, in this tract, although there are -- I 23 Ο. don't know -- 16, 18 people listed, actually how many 24 mineral interest owners are in this 120-acre tract? 25

Exhibit 3 is a summary of our communications. 4 5 It includes proposed letters to interest owners, and copies of correspondence, handwritten notes, emails, all 6 describing our communications. 7 And, again, there are certain unlocateable 8 Ο. interest owners in this tract? 9 10 Α. Correct. And, again, what did you do to try to locate 11 Ο. 12 these mineral owners? We searched through the Eddy County records, 13 Α. used several different Internet Websites to search for 14 them, and we also searched our internal records. 15 In your opinion, has Mewbourne made a 16 Q. 17 good-faith effort to locate all the interest owners or to obtain their voluntary joinder in these three wells? 18 Α. Yes, sir. 19 20 Could you identify Exhibits 4, 5 and 6 and Q. 21 describe them for the examiner? Exhibit 4 is an AFE for the Quick Draw "15" I Α. 22 No. 1 well. Exhibit 5 is a AFE for Quick Draw "15" O No. 23 1 well, and Exhibit 6 would be an AFE for the Quick Draw 24 "15" P No. 1. 25

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Page 8 1 Q. And all of these AFEs contain footage locations for these wells. Are those the accurate 2 locations for these wells? 3 Yes, sir. 4 Α. And, again, there's a completed well cost of 5 Ο. about \$914,000. Are those costs in line with the costs 6 of other wells drilled at this depth in this area? 7 Yes, sir. Α. 8 Do you request that Mewbourne be appointed 9 0. operator of the three wells? 10 11 Α. Yes, sir. 12 0. What is your recommendation for the overhead 13 rates? Does Mewbourne request the maximum cost plus 21 200 percent risk charge against any non-presenting interest owners? 22 Α. Yes, sir. 23 24 Ο. Were the parties being pooled notified of these applications? 25

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Page 9 Yes, sir. 1 Α. Are Exhibits 7, 8 and 9 Affidavits of Notice 2 Ο. for each of the three applications? 3 Α. Yes. 4 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, again, written 5 notice was attempted as to all the people who had an 6 7 address, whether or not valid, and there were certain 8 letters that never came back or were returned as unable to deliver, and that's reflected in these Affidavits. 9 MR. BROOKS: All those people where 10 included in the publication notice? 11 MR. BRUCE: Yes. THE WITNESS: Yes, sir. 24 25 MR. WARNELL: Do you know why you did
