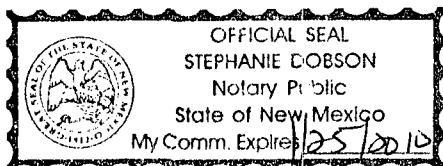

Mewbourne Oil Company has filed an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Yesso formation underlying the NW/4SE/4 of Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, to form a standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration unit for all formations spaced on 40 acres, including the Undesignated Cementery Yesso Pool. The units to be dedicated to the Quick Draw #1529 Well No. 1, to be drilled at an orthodoxy location in the NW/4SE/4 of Section 15. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The application is scheduled to be heard at 8:15 a.m. on Thursday, February 19, 2009 at the Division's offices at 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. As an interest owner in the well unit you have the right to enter an appearance and participate in the case. Failure to appear will preclude you from contesting this matter at a later date.
