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 <u>CASE 14280:</u> Application of Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company LP for an exception to the well density requirements (Low Productivity Area) of Rule 7(d) of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin Fruitland Coal-Gas Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, E/2 Section 13, T32N, R8W including a horizontal wellbore for the Reese Mesa Well No. 101 (surface in Unit P and BHL in Unit B) and the simultaneous dedication of this well with the Reese Mesa Well No. 101S (Unit Letter H) to permit it to produce these two Fruitland Coal-Gas wells in the same quarter section (NE/4) on a standard spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 13, T32N, R8W, NMPM. These wells are located approximately 12.5 miles North of the Navajo Dam's Spillway, New Mexico.

2. CASE 14281: Application of Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company to amend Order R-9918 for a downhole commingling reference case for the Allison Unit area, San Juan County, New Mexico. Applicant, in accordance with Division Rule 303.E, seeks to establish a downhole commingling reference case to extend to the entire Allison Unit. Order R-9918 authorization downhole commingling of Dakota and Mesaverde gas production in the wellbores of existing or future wells drilled anywhere within the Dakota and Mesaverde participation areas of the Allison Unit. Applicant seek to expand *this* order to also (a) include the Picture Cliffs formations, Fruitland Coal-Gas Pool, (b) include non-participation areas acreage within the Allison Unit, and (c) delete additional notice to each affected interest owners within the unit area. The Allison Unit is located in portions of Sections 7, 8, 9, 16-21, 28-31, T32N, R6 W, and in portions of Sections 9-16, 23-26, T32N, R7W, NMPM. Said unit is located approximately 4.2 miles South of Allison, Colorado.
