IMC Potash Carlsbad, Inc. submitted two applications to lease State Trust Lands. The first is for the E½E½ Section 16, T20S, R32E in Lea County (HP-0003); the second is for Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, N½S½ of Section 36, SW¼ Section 32 of T19S, R33E and Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, S½N½, S½ of Section 2, T20S, R32E in Lea County (HP-0004). Potash lease HP-0004 is in the process of being issued. However; lease HP-0003 has been determined to be not in the best interest of the Trust. Section 16 currently has numerous oil and gas well bores, and with the potential of additional drilling, there does not appear to be adequate clearance for economic mining: therefore, HP-0003 is rejected. All rental funds for the HP-0003 application will be refunded.
