
Gentlemen:

Pursuant to Division Order No. R-12990 granted by the Oil Conservation Division, Nearburg Exploration Company, L.L.C. respectfully requests an itemized schedule of actual well costs associated with the drilling and completion of the referenced well. While this well reflects a completion date of December 22, 2008 on the completion report filed with the Bureau of Land Management, the well was not frac'd until January 10, 2008. The above stated Order provides that the Operator must provide each pooled working interest owner with said schedule within ninety (90) days following completion of the well. We then have forty-five (45) days from our receipt of the schedule to deem the costs as being reasonable.

Nearburg has timely paid its proportionate share of the estimated drilling and completion costs under said Order. We strongly feel that we are entitled to the schedule of actual costs so we can determine if said costs shall be deemed to be reasonable. We believe that BOPCO has not timely provided us with the schedule of actual costs for this well.
