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Page 3 HEARING EXAMINER: In accordance with the 1 announced plan of disposition, at this time we will call 2 3 Case No. 14304. This is the Application of Burlington Resources Oil and Gas Company to Reinstate Division 4 Order R-13057 for Compulsory Pooling, San Juan County, New 5 Mexico. 6 7 Call for appearances. 8 MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, I'm Tom Kellahin of 9 the Santa Fe Law Firm of Kellahin and Kellahin, appearing this morning on behalf of the Applicant. 10 With your permission, Mr. Examiner, we'd like to 11 12 submit this by affidavit. We have no witnesses. HEARING EXAMINER: Very good. You may proceed. 13 MR. KELLAHIN: Mr. Examiner, the reason I'm back 14 before you this morning is that Burlington inadvertently 15 16 allowed a pooling order to expire without having obtained 17 prior to the expiration of the date in which they were to 18 commence the well -- or pool from the director to extend that order. 19 As part of this presentation, I have four 20 exhibits for your consideration. 21 22 The first one is Exhibit 1, simply a locator map that was used in the original hearing that shows that this 23 is a pooling of a spacing unit associated with the east 24 25 half of Section 15, Township 31 North, Range 10 West.

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Page 4 Exhibit No. 2 is a copy of the order of the case 1 2 that was presented to Mr. Warnell back on October 30th. 3 The order was dated October 20th of last year. And when you turn to the order, you'll find that 4 Burlington should have commenced the drilling of the well 5 by February 28th of this year. As a result of a clerical 6 oversight, they failed to do that. 7 8 The affidavit is the next document before you. 9 It's Exhibit No. 3. Mr. Terry Simcoe was the landman that testified before Mr. Warnell. 10 11 Mr. Simcoe is back to certify in his affidavit 12 that none of the circumstances have changed from the technical case that Mr. Warnell heard with the exception 13 of the request for the reinstatement and the extension of 14 15 the commencement date. 16 Mr. Simcoe's difficulty in this case is the tracts associated with a big game hunting area and their 17 18 restrictions on when you build your surface location and otherwise. 19 And in addition, he's not yet obtained his 20 federal APD. He now tells me that it takes maybe 220 days 21 22 to go through that process for this type of well. So rather than have another extension of this 23 order, we're requesting that you re-instate it and give us 24 until October 30th of this year as the commencement date. 25

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Page 5 HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. Well, since this order 1 was issued, the Division has adopted a policy of allowing 2 3 one year from the date of insurance of an order for commencement. 4 MR. KELLAHIN: Okay. Well, that would satisfy 5 our concerns, Mr. Examiner. 6 7 HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. 8 MR. KELLAHIN: The final exhibit is my Certificate of Notification, Exhibit 4. The original 9 hearing involved the pooling of three trust interests that 10 are identified in the pre-hearing statement. 11 Those 12 parties have chosen not to appear in this proceeding. And so to the best of my knowledge, there is no 13 opposition to the reinstatement of this order. 14 15 HEARING EXAMINER: Okay then. Are there any 16 parties that were not located? 17 MR. KELLAHIN: No, sir, not in this case. 18 HEARING EXAMINER: Very good. 19 MR. KELLAHIN: With your permission, we'd 20 request the admission of Exhibits 1, 2, 3, and 4. 21 HEARING EXAMINER: Exhibits 1 through 4 are 22 admitted. 23 MR.
