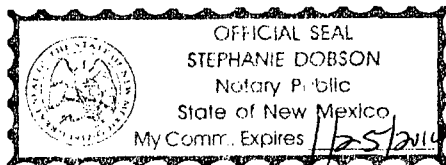

seeking an order pool-
ing all mineral inter-
ests from the surface
to the base of the Up-
per Pennsylvanian
formation underlying
the following de-
scribed acreage: In
Section 13, Township
24N, Range 28E,
East of NMPM, Eddy
County, New Mexico,
and in the following
manner: The W/2 to
form a standard 320-
acre gas spacing and
proration unit for any
and all formations or
pools developed on
320-acre spacing with
in that vertical ex-
tent; and the NW/4 to
form a standard 160-
acre oil or gas spac-
ing and proration unit
for any and all forma-
tions or pools devel-
oped on 160-acre spac-
ing within that verti-
cal extent. The units
are to be dedicated to
the Crot Well No. 21,
to be re-entered at a
location 1980 feet
from the north line
and 660 feet from the
west line of Section
13. Also to be consid-
ered will be the cost
of re-entering and
completing the well
and the allocation of
the cost thereof, as
well as actual operat-
ing costs and charges
for supervision, desig-
nation of applicant as
operator of the well,
and a 200% charge for
the risk involved in
re-entering and com-
pleting the well. The
application is sched-
