BY THE DIVISION:

This case came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on October 16, 2008, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiners Richard Ezeanyim, David K. Brooks and Terry Warnell.

NOW, on this 9th day of June, 2009, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiners,

FINDS THAT:

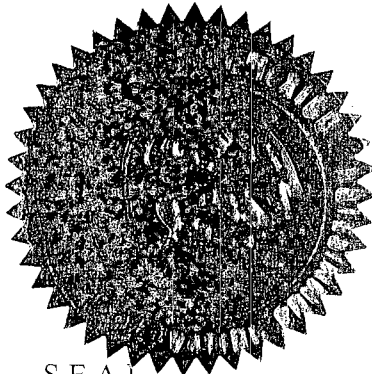
- (1) Due notice has been given, and the Division has jurisdiction of the subject matter of this case.
- (2) This case involves an application to inject pursuant to Division Rule 26.8.
- (3) Rule 26.8.A provides, in pertinent part, that "[t]he Division shall grant a permit for injection under 19.15.26.8 NMAC only to an operator who is in compliance with Subsection A of 19.15.5.9 NMAC."
- (4) Division records indicate that the Applicant, Dennis Langlitz, is out of compliance with Rule 5.9, in that 8 of the 13 wells that Langlitz operates are inactive.
- (5) Accordingly, this application for authority to inject should be dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The Application of Dennis Langlitz (OGRID 157447) for authority to inject is hereby dismissed without prejudice.

(2) Jurisdiction of this case is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
