AFFIDAVIT OF NOTICE

My name is Theresa Duran-Saenz, and I am a Legal Assistant with the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department. I am providing this affidavit to supply additional information about the three newspapers that published the notice in Case No. 14255: The Santa Fe New Mexican, the Rio Rancho Observer, and the Las Vegas Optic.

- 1. The Santa Fe New Mexican. The Santa Fe New Mexican is a daily newspaper. On December 9, 2008, I telephoned Mike Reichard, Director of Circulation for the Santa Fe New Mexican, and asked him how many copies of the newspaper are circulated in San Miguel and Sandoval Counties. On December 10, 2008, I received an e-mail from Mr. Reichard, which is attached as Exhibit A to this affidavit. According to Mr. Reichard's e-mail, the Santa Fe New Mexican delivers an average of 491 papers per day in Sandoval County, and 659 papers per day in San Miguel County.
- 2. The Rio Rancho Observer. On December 9, 2008, I contacted Wendy, the Advertisement Manager for The Rio Rancho Observer, and asked her for information on the paper's circulation. Her faxed response is attached to this affidavit as Exhibit B. According to the fax, the Rio Rancho Observer is currently published once a week and is delivered free to homes in the Rio Rancho area, in zip codes 87124 and 87144. Rio Rancho is located in Sandoval County. Using an on-line search engine, I checked to see if zip codes 87124 and 87144 are included in that portion of Sandoval County that will be affected by the rule changes proposed in Case No. 14255. Those two zip codes are in the Rio Rancho area, which is south of that portion of Sandoval County affected by the proposed rule changes. Attached to this affidavit as Exhibit C is a map generated by that search engine, showing the area covered by zip codes 87144 and 87124. For a point of reference, the map also shows the location of Santo Domingo Pueblo, zip code 87052, which is close to that portion of Sandoval County affected by the proposed rule changes.
- 3. The Las Vegas Optic. On December 9, 2008, I contacted Crissy Johnson, the Circulation Director for the Las Vegas Optic and asked her for information on the paper's circulation. Her e-mail response is attached to this affidavit as Exhibit D. According to her e-mail, the Las Vegas Optic has a weekly circulation of 20,000 papers in San Miguel County.

This concludes my affidavit.


