- 1 to be picking or choosing who hears the cases. All my
- 2 examiners are very capable of hearing any case, except
- 3 when it comes to the legal part. I have no idea.
- So we are going to seek to develop a rotation,
- 5 hearing rotation, and we stick by it. But if you have a
- 6 need to request something because it's really
- 7 particularly important to you, I will base it on legal.
- 8 We are all tecnical examiners and are very competent to
- 9 handle the technical issues, but if it's legal and you
- 10 want to request David to be there, I will comply with
- 11 that. But I don't want anybody picking and choosing who
- 12 hears a case or not.
- I wanted to say that there's a lot of in-house
- 14 things we do, but these are the ones I want to
- 15 communicate to you guys. Are there any questions or
- 16 comments, you know, adverse effects or something? We
- 17 have to make sure you know how we are handling our
- 18 operations.
- Then we go about our business of today. Today
