And I gather this was continued from August the 7th to supplement the record; is that correct?

MR. BRUCE: That's correct, Mr. Examiner. If I may,
Mr. Examiner, this case was -- I should say Jim Bruce,
representing the applicant.

This case was heard two weeks ago, and the testimony was submitted. There was one question, I think it was,

Mr. Jones had regarding this case -- two questions similar.

This case involves the SE/4 of Section 16 which

Forest refers to as its State B lease, which is where the

secondary recovery project is requested. There was one

question which was what is the ownership of the State B lease.

Obviously it's a State lease, and Forest Oil owns 100 percent

of the working interest.

I've submitted this affidavit to you marked Exhibit 11 from the landman at Forest Oil. In paragraph 4, he states that working interest ownership in the State B lease from the surface to the base of the San Andres formation which includes the injection zone, the Grayburg Jackson pool, is 100 percent owned by Forest Oil Corporation.

The second question -- it also came up during the examination that the offsetting Skelly unit has an ongoing

waterflood, and the two projects are kind of related. A question was also raised as the ownership in the working interest in the Skelly unit. And that's addressed in the paragraph 5 of this affidavit. If you look at Attachment A to Exhibit 11, there is a land plat of the Skelly unit. It's a 100 percent federal unit which offsets the SE/4 of Section 16, as you can see. It's all federal leases. And all of the acreage except 120 acres is in a participating area for the Grayburg Jackson pool.

And in so as far as depths from surface to 5,000 feet, Forest Oil Corporation owns 100 percent of the working interest. That addresses Mr. Jones second question.

And just for historical purposes, I think we had some discussion about the Skelly unit. I've attached the -- the first page didn't copy well, but the unit agreement for the Skelly unit which was formed in 1937 -- probably one of the first units formed in the State of New Mexico -- the earliest units approval I could see from the Division was in 1950 for unit agreements -- and this unit was formed in 1937.

As I noted on the record last time, it's a voluntary unit. The unit was formed for exploration and it later -- later a waterflood was instituted in the unit. And I think the waterflood expansion orders are referenced in the prior testimony.

So with that, I submit Exhibit 11. The landman is
