Amended Application of Energen Resources Corporation to Amend the Cost Recovery Provisions of Compulsory Pooling Order No. R-1960, To Determine Reasonable Costs, and for Authorization To Recover Costs From Production Of Pooled Mineral Interests, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. Applicant seeks an order amending the cost recovery provisions of Order No. R-1960 pooling all interests in the Pictured Cliffs formation, (Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool) underlying the SW/4 of Section 2, Township 25 North, Range 3 West, forming a standard 160-acre spacing and proration unit. Applicant proposes the amendment of the cost recovery provisions under the original version of Order No. R-1960 to reflect the current custom and practice of the industry and the Division which allows well operators to recover the reasonable costs of operations and supervision. Applicant also seeks authorization to sell a portion or all of the pooled working interest share of production of a non-selling mineral interest owner and to obtain reimbursement of costs therefrom.
