

On September 6, 2006 the San Juan 32-7 Unit Thirty-Second Expansion for the Fruitland Coal formation was submitted to our office for approval. The approval for this expansion was accomplished on October 11, 2006. The submission of this expansion caused the following Communitization Agreement (CA) to become obsolete due to the inclusion into the Fruitland Coal participating area.

NMNM-114795, E½ of Sec. 8 and W½W½ of Sec. 9, T32N, R7W dedication for the San Juan 32-7 Unit #249, Effective 08/03/2005

This agreement communitized particular acres of Federal lands within the San Juan 32-7 Unit as to natural gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons producible from the Fruitland Coal formation. The term of the agreement was for 2 years and for so long thereafter as communitized substances are produced in paying quantities.

Our records indicate that the well dedicated to the described agreements were completed and that the public interest requirements for the communitization agreement, pursuant to 43 CFR 3105.2-3, have been met.

The effective termination date of this CA is September 1, 2005, this date being the effective date of the Thirty-Second Expansion to the Fruitland Coal formation. All subject Federal leases involved with this CA are held by the Unit. All indicated well will report to 8910004410 (NMNM78423A) (Fruitland Coal participating area for the San Juan 32-7 Unit) from effective termination date of the CA.


