7. Description of Undertaking (what does the project entail?): On 11 January, 2008, Jeffrey Pangburn, with Boone Archaeological Services conducted a class III archaeological survey to meet the federal and state laws for preserving and protecting cultural resources. These laws include, but are not limited to, Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and Executive Order 11593 for C.O.G Operating LLC. This survey was designed to meet, or exceed, the requirements detailed in the BLM Manual Supplement H-8100-1 New Mexico, Oklahoma, and Texas, Procedures for performing Cultural Resource Fieldwork on Public Lands in the area of New Mexico BLM Responsibilities 2002. The proposed project is located in Eddy County, New Mexico. The proposed project is for the proposed Blackhawk "11" Federal com well #1 pad and an associated access road. The project consists of a 600' x 600' survey area for the Blackhawk "11" Federal Com well #1 pad. The impact area is unknown but estimated to be 400' x 400'. The access road starts at the northwest portion of the well pad and extends southwest. The road ends at an existing bladed and maintained lease road. The overall length of the access road is 5340.7' (+/-) and was surveyed with a 100' survey corridor centered on the marked right of way. The impact area is unknown but estimated to be a 50' wide corridor centered on the marked right of way. A total of 150' (+/-) of the proposed access road is with in the survey area of the well pad leaving 5190.7' (+/-) of newly surveyed footage along the access road. The project crosses a lease road and an overhead electric line and is within a grazed modern cattle pasture. The area is desert scrubland with copice dunes and various interdunal areas. During the course of field work no cultural materials were encountered. The location plots for the project were obtained by utilizing a hand held GPS unit. The project right of way was delineated by the client prior to field work with lathe and marking tape

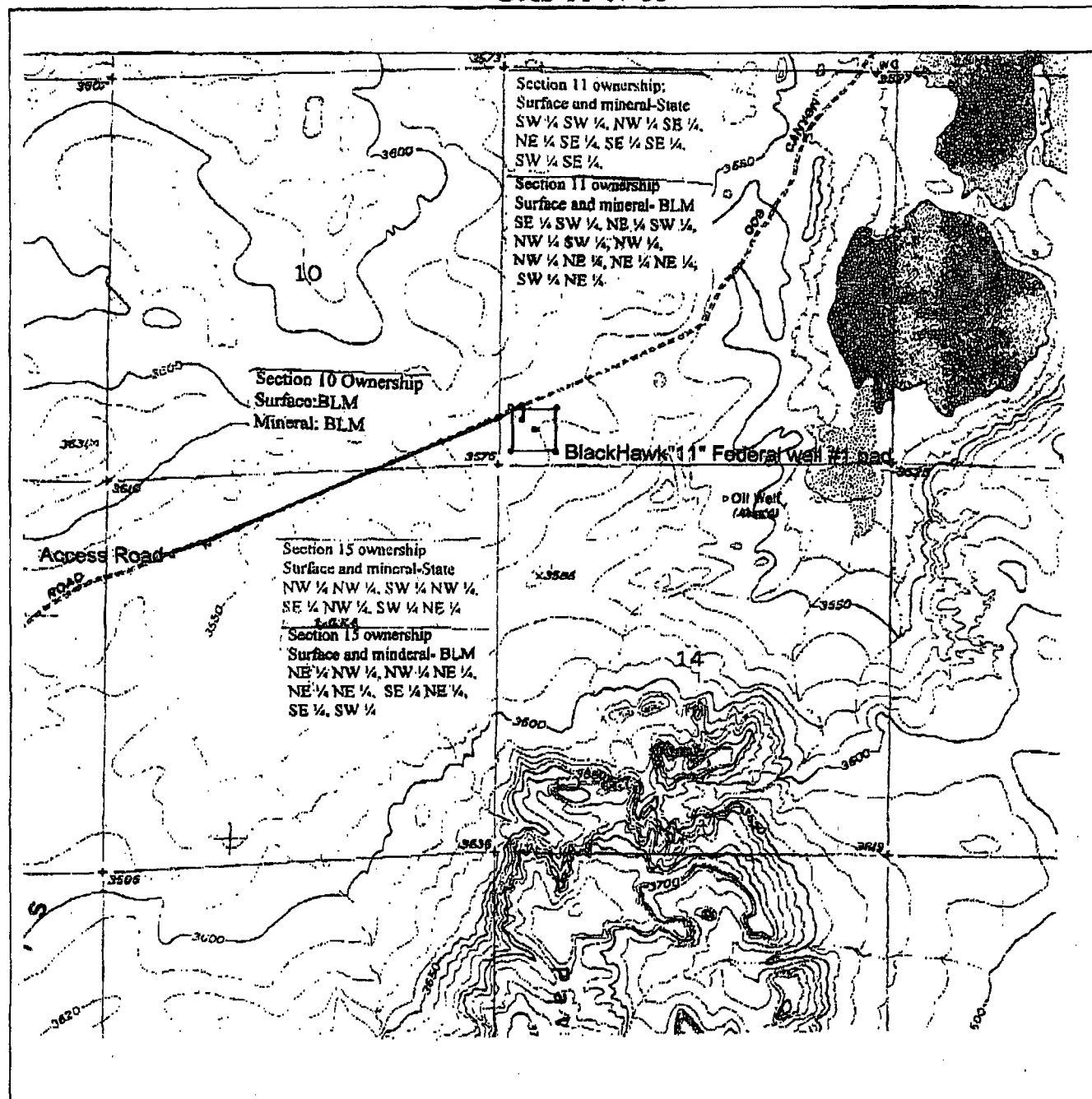
