Dear Mr. Hopkins:

Our records reflect that Parallel Production Corp. is the operator of record for the Hope State Exploratory Unit, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Article 8, Drilling to Discovery provides that: The unit operator shall, within sixty (60) days after the effective date of this agreement, commence operations upon an adequate test well for oil and gas upon some part of the lands embraced within the unit area and shall drill said well with due diligence to a depth sufficient to attain the top of the Wolfcamp shale formation or to such a depth as unitized substances shall be discovered in paying quantities at a lesser depth or until it shall, in the opinion of unit operator, be determined that the further drilling of said well shall be unwarranted or impracticable; provided, however, that unit operator shall not, in any event, be required to drill said well to a depth in excess of 5,000 feet. Until a discovery of a deposit of unitized substances capable of being produced in paying quantities (to wit: quantities sufficient to repay the costs of drilling and producing operations with a reasonable profit) unit operator shall continue drilling diligently, one well at a time, allowing not more than six months between the completion of one well and the beginning of the next well, until a well capable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities is completed to the satisfaction of the Commissioner or until it is reasonably proven to the satisfaction of the unit operator that the unitized land is incapable of producing unitized substances in paying quantities in the formation drilled hereunder.

Any well commenced prior to the effective date of this agreement upon the unit area and drilled to the depth provided herein for the drilling of an initial test well shall be considered as complying with the drilling requirements hereof with respect to the initial well. The Commissioner may modify the drilling requirements of this section by granting reasonable extensions of time when in his opinion such action is warranted. Upon failure to comply with the drilling provisions of this article the Commissioner may, after reasonable notice to the unit operator and each working interest owner, lessee and lessor at their last known address, declare this unit agreement terminated, and all rights, privileges and obligations granted and assumed by this unit agreement shall cease and terminate as of such date.

Our records reflect the following:

- The Hope State Unit Agreement was approved effective March 1, 2007.
- The initial well (API #30-015-35377), the Hope Unit 1821-16 State Well No. 1 was plugged and abandoned on April 24, 2007 and the Hope Unit 1821-16 #1Y was drilled as a replacement well.
- The Hope Unit 1821-16 #1Y (API #30-015-35561) was drilled as a horizontal well and completed on August 7, 2007. This well is currently producing in the WC Hope Mound; Wolfcamp (G) pool. Your letter of November 16, 2007 notified this office that this well does not meet the parameters to qualify as a unit well and submitted a Communitization agreement.
- Pursuant to Article 8 of the unit agreement, the second exploratory well was due to be commenced on or before February 7, 2008 being six months from the completion date of the initial well.
- The second exploratory well (API #30-015-35378), the Hope Unit 1821-15 State Well No. 2 was never drilled and the drilling permit has been cancelled.
- Pursuant to your phone conversation with Pete Martinez on May 20, 2008 you acknowledged that Parallel does not intend to further develop the unit area and the unit should be terminated.

In view of the above, please be advised that the Hope State Exploratory Unit Agreement has been terminated effective February 7, 2008.
