Preliminary Approval Proposed Banquet Unit Eddy County, New Mexico

Dear Mr.Ramage:

This office has received the unexecuted copy of the unit agreement, which you have submitted for the proposed Banquet Unit area, Eddy County, New Mexico. This agreement meets the general requirements of the Commissioner of Public Lands, who has this date granted you preliminary approval as to form and content.

Preliminary approval shall not be construed to mean final approval of this agreement in any way and will not extend any short term leases, until final approval and an effective date have been given.

When submitting your agreement for final approval, please submit the following:

- Application for final approval by the Commissioner setting forth the tracts that have been committed and the tracts that have not been committed.
- 2. Pursuant to Rule 19.2.100.51, applications for approval shall contain a statement of facts showing:
 - a. That such agreement will tend to promote the conservation of oil and gas and the better utilization of reservoir energy.
 - b. That under the proposed unit operation, the State of New Mexico will receive its fair share of the recoverable oil and gas in place under its lands in the proposed unit area.
 - c. That each beneficiary institution of the State of New Mexico will receive its fair and equitable share of the recoverable oil and gas under its lands within the unit area.
 - d. That such unit agreement is in other respects for the best interest of the trust.

- 3. All ratifications from the Lessees of Record and Working Interest Owners. All signatures should be acknowledged by a notary and one set must contain original signatures.
- 4. Designation from the Bureau of Land Management.
- 5. Order of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. Our approval will be conditioned upon subsequent favorable approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division and the Bureau of Land Management.
- 6. Please submit two copies of the Unit Agreement.
- 7. A copy of the Unit Operating Agreement (if applicable).
- 8. Copies of all the well records for the initial unit well.
- 9. The filing fee for a unit agreement is thirty dollars for every section or partial section thereof. Please submit a \$60 filing fee.

Dear Mr. Ramage,

Your application of April 14, 2008, filed with the Bureau of Land Management, requests the designation of the Banquet Unit area, embracing 960.00 acres, more or less, in Eddy County, New Mexico, as logically subject to exploration and development under the unitization provisions of the Mineral Leasing Act as amended.

Pursuant to unit plan regulations 43 CFR 3180, the land requested as outlined on your plat marked Exhibit "A", the Banquet Unit area, Eddy County, New Mexico, is hereby designated as a logical unit area and has been assigned No. NMNM120407X. This designation is valid for a period of one year from the date of this letter.

The unit agreement submitted for the area designated must provide for a well to test the base of the middle Morrow formation, or to a depth of 8,230 feet. Your proposed use of the Form of Agreement for unproven areas at 43 CFR 3186.1 will be accepted. If conditions are such that further modification of said standard form is deemed necessary, three copies of the proposed modifications with appropriate justification must be submitted to this office for preliminary approval.

In the absence of any type of land requiring special provisions or of any objections not now apparent, a duly executed agreement identical with said form, modified as outlined above, will be approved if submitted in approvable status within a reasonable period of time. However, notice is hereby given that the right is reserved to deny approval of any executed agreement submitted that, in our opinion, does not have the full commitment of sufficient lands to afford effective control of operations in the unit area.

When the executed agreement is transmitted to the BLM for approval, please include the latest status of all acreage. In preparation of Exhibits "A" and "B", follow closely the format of the sample exhibits attached to the reprint of the aforementioned form. A minimum of three copies of the executed agreement should be submitted with your request for final approval.

Copies of this letter are being sent to the Commissioner of Public Lands and the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as this proposed unit area contains State lands.


