STATEMENT OF CASE

APPLICANT

Applicant seeks approval of ITS Round Tank-Queen Waterflood Unit comprised of 1922.72 acres, more or less of State of New Mexico and Federal lands located in Chaves County, New Mexico, more particularly described as follows:

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 28 EAST, NMPM

Section 24: E/2, E/2 W/2

Section 25: E/2

TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 28 EAST, NMPM

Irregular Section 19: Lots 1 through 4, E/2 W/2

(W/2 Equivalent), SE/4

Irregular Section 30: Lots 1 through 4, E/2 W/2

(W/2 Equivalent), E/2

Applicant seeks authorization to inject water into the Queen formation, round Tank-Queen pool, through its proposed round Tank Federal Well No. 1 to be drilled 715 feet from the North line and 825 feet from the East line of Section 30, Township 15 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. Applicant proposes to inject up to 200 barrels of water per day at a maximum injection pressure of 300 psi, into the Queen formation, at an approximate depth of 1575 feet to 1590 feet.

The applicant requests that the Division establish procedures for administrative approval of additional injection wells within the project area without the necessity of further hearings and the adoption of such other provisions as are necessary for said waterflood operations. Applicant further seeks to qualify the project area for the Recovered Oil Tax Rate pursuant to the "New Mexico Enhanced Oil Recovery Act" (Laws 1992, Chapter 38, Sections 1 through 5).
