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- 1 MR. BROOKS: We'll call Case Number 14386,
- 2 application of Mewbourne Oil Company for compulsory
- 3 pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 4 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Good morning, Mr.
- 5 Examiner. Ocean Munds-Dry with the law firm of Holland &
- 6 Hart, LLC, here representing Mewbourne Oil Company this
- 7 morning. I am presenting this case by affidavit.
- 8 Mr. Examiner, I've handed you a packet
- 9 containing Exhibit 1 and its attachments. Exhibit 1 is
- 10 the affidavit of Mr. Haden, who is the landman
- 11 responsible for this acreage. And Mewbourne seeks an
- order pooling all mineral interests from a depth of 3,350
- 13 feet subsurface to the base of the Morrow Formation in
- 14 the south half of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 30
- 15 East in Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 16 Mewbourne owns working interest in the south
- 17 half of Section 29 and has dedicated the proposed spacing
- 18 unit to its Bradley "29" Federal Com Well No. 1, to be
- 19 drilled at a location 660 feet from the south line and
- 20 1,980 feet from the east line to a depth of approximately
- 21 11,800 feet.
- 22 Attachment A to Exhibit 1 is the plat showing
- 23 the location of the proposed spacing unit and the
- 24 location of the well. Attachment B shows the nature and
- 25 percentage of ownership interests in the subject spacing

- 1 units, and you can see that they've broken it down by the
- 2 various lease interests.
- MR. BROOKS: Now, you gave me the footages
- 4 a minute ago, and I don't see that those are on the AFE,
- 5 so can you give me that again?
- 6 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Yes, sir. It is 650 feet
- 7 from the south line and 1,980 feet from the east line.
- 8 MR. BROOKS: Okay. Go ahead.
- 9 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you. This
- 10 application has been instituted solely to pool the
- 11 interests of certain working interest owners who do not
- 12 oppose this application. And in Attachment C, you will
- 13 also see that we've included the relevant correspondence
- 14 and the well proposal letter that went out to these
- 15 working interest owners.
- Also, at the back of this packet is the
- 17 summary of communications. It's a three-page document
- 18 that lists all of the efforts -- all of the good-faith
- 19 efforts that Mewbourne undertook to gain the voluntary
- 20 participation of those working interest owners.
- MR. BROOKS: Where is the list of the
- 22 working interest owners being pooled?
- 23 MS. MUNDS-DRY: That is -- I think that's
- 24 probably in our last attachment, Attachment E. It shows
- 25 you Exhibit A to the application, which is the notice

- 1 list, and gives you all of the interest owners being
- 2 pooled, which is Edge Petroleum; Marilyn J. Cone,
- 3 Trustee; Kenneth G. Cone, Individually and as Trustee;
- 4 Tom R. Cone; Randy Lee Cone; Kathy Cone-McCown -- if I'm
- 5 saying that correctly -- Clifford Cone; and Robert J.
- 6 Leonard and Marian M. Leonard, Trustees of the Leonard
- 7 Trust.
- 8 MR. BROOKS: Okay.
- 9 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Attachment D, Mr.
- 10 Examiner, as I think you already found, is the copy of
- 11 the AFE that was sent to those interest owners.
- 12 Mewbourne estimates the cost of the casing point to be
- 13 \$1,235,500, and a completed well cost of \$1,958,000.
- 14 Mewbourne plans to drill this well by December
- 15 1st, 2009, and as I previously mentioned, Attachment E is
- 16 a copy of the notice letter sent to those interest
- 17 owners, as well as my affidavit indicating that notice
- 18 was given, and, of course, finally, the affidavit of
- 19 publication that was issued pursuant to Division rules,
- 20 and then lastly, the copy of the green cards.
- 21 MR. BROOKS: You have an affidavit of
- 22 publication. Did you get notice to all of the persons,
- 23 or was there some people that had to be served up by
- 24 publication?
- MS. MUNDS-DRY: Yeah. As I understand it,

- 1 we were able to get it to most of them, but because we
- 2 were not sure about some of these addresses, we went
- 3 ahead and published in the newspaper.
- 4 MR. BROOKS: Okay. And the green cards
- 5 you have are attached?
- 6 MS. MUNDS-DRY: The green cards we have
- 7 are attached. I believe there was only one that did not
- 8 come back, from Robert Leonard and Marian Leonard. The
- 9 rest we received green cards back.
- MR. BROOKS: Very good.
- 11 MS. MUNDS-DRY: With that we ask that this
- 12 application be granted to prevent waste and to protect
- 13 correlative rights, and allow Mewbourne and the other
- 14 interest owners in the south half of Section 29 the
- 15 opportunity to obtain their just and fair share of the
- 16 oil and gas on their lands. And with that, we ask that
- 17 Exhibit 1 and Attachments A through E be admitted into
- 18 evidence.
- MR. BROOKS: Exhibit 1 and attachments are
- 20 admitted. If there's nothing further, Case Number 14386
- 21 will be taken under advisement.
- 22 (Exhibit 1 was admitted.)
- 23 MS. MUNDS-DRY: Thank you, Mr. Examiner.
