## Re: Case No. 14054, Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Compliance Order Against Kimlar Oil Company, Eddy County, New Mexico

Dear Mr. Ezeanyim:

By letter dated November 2, 2009, I requested that the case, set for hearing on November 12, 2009, be dismissed. I now realize, however, that this may have caused you to believe that I want the case to be dismissed but this is not true. What I meant to say was that I want to withdraw my motion to re-open the case and vacate the hearing set for that date.

I filed the motion to re-open the case when Kimlar Oil Company (Kimlar) failed to comply with Ordering Paragraph 5 of Order No. R-12967 and install or implement a spill prevention system approved by the Artesia Oil Conservation Division (OCD) District Office designed to reduce or eliminate stuffing box leaks and other spills from its wells and operations. After I filed the motion to re-open, Kimlar complied with the Order and installed a spill prevention system approved by the Artesia OCD District Office. Since Kimlar has complied with this Order requirement, I am requesting to withdraw my motion to re-open the case and to vacate the hearing scheduled for November 12, 2009.
