APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in all formations from the surface to the base of the Mississippian in the following described spacing and proration units located in Section 12, Township 15 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico:

- The W/2 for all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing which includes but is not necessarily limited to the North Eidson Morrow Pool;
- The SW/4 for all formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre spacing;
- The N/2 SW/4 for all formations and/or pools developed on 80-acre spacing; and
- The NE/4 SW/4 (Unit K) for all formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre spacing.

Said units are to be dedicated to the Reed AXV Com. Well No. 1, which is an existing Wolfcamp oil well at an unorthodox gas well location 1870 feet from the South line and 2080 feet from the West line (Unit K) of said Section 12. Yates seeks to re-enter and deepen this existing oil well to an approximate depth of 13,400 feet in order to test the Austin Cycle, Morrow and Atoka formations. In addition to the approval of this unorthodox gas well location, Yates Petroleum Corporation seeks to be designated operator of the well and requests that the Division impose a 200% risk penalty against the non-consenting interest owners pursuant to Division Rule 19.15.1.35. Said area is located approximately 10 miles northeast of Lovington, New Mexico.
