- 1 HEARING EXAMINER: At this time we will call
- 2 Case No. 14433, the Application of Mewbourne Oil Company
- 3 for Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Call for
- 4 appearances.
- 5 MR. CARR: May it please the Examiner, my name
- 6 is William F. Carr with the Santa Fe office of Holland and
- 7 Hart, LLP. We represent Mewbourne Oil Company in this
- 8 matter, and I request permission to present the case by
- 9 affidavit.
- 10 HEARING EXAMINER: You may proceed.
- MR. CARR: Mr. Examiner, Exhibit 1 is an
- 12 affidavit of Paul Haden who is a landman for Midland with
- over 29 years experience in the Permian Basin.
- 14 His affidavit shows that Mewbourne seeks an
- 15 order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to
- 16 the top of the Bone Spring formation in the northeast
- 17 quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 17, Township
- 18 19 South, Range 26 East in Eddy County, New Mexico.
- 19 Mewbourne owns a working interest in the
- 20 proposed spacing unit for which it plans to dedicate its
- 21 Wyatt Draw 17 K Well No. 1, which will be located at a
- 22 standard location on that acreage.
- 23 Attached to Mr. Haden's affidavit as
- 24 Attachment A is a plat that just shows generally the
- location of the spacing unit and the well location.

- Exhibit B is a list of the owners in the subject
- 2 spacing unit and their percentage working interest
- 3 ownership is set out.
- 4 If you will note, there are asterisks indicating
- 5 that only three of those parties, Isramco Energy, LLC,
- 6 Nadel & Gussman, and Trainer Partners, those are the only
- 7 parties who are subject to pooling in this case. And as
- 8 the affidavit shows, these parties are not opposing the
- 9 pooling application.
- 10 Mewbourne states it has made a good-faith effort
- 11 to locate and gain voluntary participation of each of
- 12 those individuals.
- 13 And Attachment C is a copy of the well proposal
- 14 and relevant correspondence concerning this pooling
- 15 application.
- Mewbourne requests that the interests be pooled
- 17 and that it be designated the operator of the well.
- 18 Mewbourne is seeking overhead charges at a combined fixed
- 19 rate of \$4,000 a month while drilling, and \$400 a month
- 20 while producing the well.
- These rates are contained in Mewbourne's January
- 22 26, 2010 joint operating agreement for the property that
- 23 has been executed by all the interest owners on Exhibit B
- 24 except three parties subject to pooling.
- 25 An AFE for the well is also enclosed which shows

- 1 that the estimated costs to the casing point are \$283,600,
- with completed well costs of \$622,500.
- Mewbourne plans to drill the well by March 15th,
- 4 and therefore requests that the Order be expedited to the
- 5 extent possible.
- 6 Exhibit E is a notice affidavit and a copy of
- 7 the notice and affidavit of publication from the newspaper
- 8 in Lovington.
- 9 We believe that approval of the application will
- 10 protect correlative rights and afford Mewbourne and the
- other interest owners in this spacing unit an opportunity
- 12 to obtain their fair share of the oil and gas under the
- 13 subject lands.
- 14 And we request that Exhibit 1 and all
- 15 attachments be admitted into the record and that the case
- 16 be taken under advisement.
- 17 HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. All these things are
- 18 Exhibit 1?
- MR. CARR: Yes, sir.
- 20 HEARING EXAMINER:\ Okay. Exhibit 1 and
- 21 Attachments A through E, inclusive, are admitted. Now,
- 22 did you get return receipts from the three parties that
- are proposed to be pooled?
- 24 MR. CARR: Trainer Partners have a return
