Page 3 HEARING EXAMINER: We'll next call Case 1 No. 14423, the Amended Application of COG Operating, LLC 2 for Expansion of Pool Boundaries, Eddy County, New Mexico. 3 Call for appearances. 4 MR. HALL: Mr. Examiner, Scott Hall of 5 6 Montgomery and Andrews Law Firm of Santa Fe, appearing on 7 behalf of COG Operating. We'll be presenting this case by 8 affidavit this morning. 9 Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce of Santa Fe MR. BRUCE: 10 representing Nearburg Exploration Company, LLC. I have no 11 witnesses. 12 HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. You may proceed. 13 MR. HALL: Mr. Examiner, the Applicant is 14 requesting the extension of the pool boundaries for the 15 Crow Flats Wolfcamp Pool in order to fully encompass a nonstandard spacing unit that it has dedicated to its 16 17 Comet 32 Federal Well No. 3 of the unit that's in the 18 south half north half of Section 22, Township & south, 19 Range 28 east in Eddy County. 20 The problem we ran into was when the communitization agreement, which would consolidate two 21 federal leases, was submitted to the BLM, the BLM sent 22 23 back an approval on the condition that the Applicant 24 obtain an extension of the pool boundaries to cover the 25 entirety of the unit.

1 We pointed out to the BLM that the entirety of 2 the unit would be located within the undesignated portions 3 of the pool anyway. That argument had no effect on the 4 BLM and they said, "You do it within six months." So here 5 we are.

We looked for a way to do it administratively with the district office and the Santa Fe office and just couldn't make that happen. So I proceeded to file for a hearing.

10 The affidavit of Jan Spradlin is before you and 11 it explains the situation. It also includes a copy of the 12 communitization agreement showing the consolidation of all 13 the interests.

There is a plat there showing the surface and bottom hole locations for this horizontal well, and Exhibit B to that shows the two leases that are consolidated.

18 There is also attached the BLM's August 17, 2009 19 letter with that particular requirement in bold. We were 20 given six months from last August to accomplish this, and 21 I've since gotten the BLM to agree to another six month 22 extension of time to do that.

As you will see in the affidavit, the acreage is subject to an operating agreement with Nearburg. And the extension of the pool has no bearing on ownership at all.

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Page 5 No one's interests are inflated or diminished by virtue of 1 2 the extension. So, it seems fairly ministerial to me. 3 So we would request an extension of the pool boundaries. And 4 the admission of Exhibit 1, the affidavit, will also 5 provide you with our notice affidavit. 6 I didn't see that notice was required in this 7 COG is the only operator in this pool, but out of 8 case. 9 precaution, I notified all operators in all surrounding 10 sections with Abo Wolfcamp wells. I'll provide that to 11 you. HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. That should take care 12 13 of any possibly notice issues. And you got returns from everybody? 14 15 MR. HALL: Yes. HEARING EXAMINER: Very good. Mr. Bruce? 16 17 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, I'll submit a letter 18 to you just stating that Nearburg is fully in support of 19 COG's application. HEARING EXAMINER: Okay. Did you have anything, 20 Mr. Jones? 21 22 MR. JONES: I was going to ask if our district qeologist had any objections to this? 23 24 I made inquires of her and did not MR. HALL: 25 hear back. So I assume not.
