STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. seeks an order approving a 159.08-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of Lots 1-4 of Section 5, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation underlying (i) Lot 4 of Section 5 to form a standard 39.72 acre oil spacing and proration unit, and (ii) Lots 1-4 of Section 5 to form a non-standard 159.08 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area), for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Mark Twain 5 Fed. Com. Well No. 4, a horizontal well to be drilled at an unorthodox surface location in Lot 4, with a terminus at an orthodox location in the Lot 1, of

Section 5. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well.
