<u>CASE 14387</u>: (Continued from the March 4, 2010 Examiner Hearing.) Application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for a Compliance Order against Dennis Langlitz. The Applicant seeks an order revoking Operator's authority to inject into his wells and pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-14(B), an order requiring Operator to plug and abandon all the wells he operates in New Mexico and authorizing Applicant to plug and abandon the wells and forfeit the applicable financial assurance in the event of non-compliance. <u>CASE 14458</u>; Application of Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. for a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Devon Energy Production Company, L.P. seeks an order approving a 159.08-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of Lots 1-4 of Section 5, Township 17 South, Range 28 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests from

the surface to the base of the Wolfcamp formation underlying (i) Lot 4 of Section 5 to form a standard 39.72 acre oil spacing and proration unit, and (ii) Lots 1-4 of Section 5 to form a non-standard 159.08 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area), for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The units are to be dedicated to the Mark Twain 5 Fed. Com. Well No. 4, a horizontal well to be drilled at an unorthodox surface location in Lot 4, with a terminus at an orthodox location in the Lot 1, of Section 5. Cimarex Energy Co. seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Wolfcamp formation comprised of the S/2 S/2 of Section 15, Township 25 South, Range 26 East, NMPM. The units are located approximately 7 miles Southeast of Whites City, New Mexico.

Applicant seeks an order approving the drilling of its proposed State 14 Com.
