Dear Mr. Hegarty:

The Oil Conservation Division (OCD) received your letter dated April 21, 2010, regarding the referenced subject on April 26, 2010. The OCD has reviewed your request and hereby extends the date to commence the drilling of this well to December 31, 2011, <u>as long as the operator does not use this extension to hold monies already paid by participating working interest owners.</u>

The operator shall do the following for any future request for extension of time to drill this well:

- (a) Give notice to all the original locatable interest owners in the pooled unit;
- (b) Wait for twenty (20) days to give the interest owners the opportunity to object or not;
- (c) If no objection is received after 20 days, then the operator shall submit the request with proof of notice; and
- (d) If any objection is received, the operator shall set the case for hearing before any extension may be granted
