Bill,

I would appreciate your assistance with San Juan Resources uncontested compulsory pooling case #14464 at the OCD hearing tomorrow. Earl DeBrine is bring you the documents--The two parties to be pooled are Union Pacific, a unleased mineral owner in Tract 3 and Four Star a working interest owner in tract 8-20

Earl has the affidavit and certificate of notification.

I do not feel well enough to attend the hearing--my resting heart rate is 161 beats per minute and I need oxygen almost 24 hours a day. The pacemaker appears to be working correctly but after they took me off the rhythm medication I've lost control of the heart rate and the heart is in almost constant palpitations--I'm told I will not die. The next step is to start a different rhythm drug. I am told that it may take 6-month to get this under control
