Yates Petroleum Corporation Case 13057

Yates seeks

- the possibility of administrative approval for unorthodox locations in the Pecos Slope Abo and the West Pecos Slope Abo pools, and
- 2 reduction of the notice period for a non-standard location from 30 days to 20 days in order to be consistent with other notice requirements

Present Situation = Order R-9976-C, promulgated March 19, 1996

- 1. Spacing unit contains 160 acres consisting of governmental quarter section
- 2. Non-standard spacing unit can be approved administratively if offset operators are notified by registered mail or certified mail and no one objects within 30 days
- 3. An optional second well is allowed in each 160-acre spacing unit
- 4. Both first well and optional second well must be at least 660 feet from outer boundary of the quarter section
- 5. Each well must be at least 10 feet from inner quarter-quarter section boundary
- 6. Unorthodox well location can be granted only after notice and hearing.

First Change = Eliminate mandatory hearing for unorthodox location

- 1. Retain notice to offset operators by registered or certified mail
- 2. Allow administrative approval if no one objects within 20 days
- 3. Schedule a hearing if an offset operator objects or if NMOCD desires a hearing
- 4. Main reason for change = result will be a more efficient process that still protects the interests of offset operators they would receive the same notice as required by present rules
- 5. History since 1996 = operator encroaches upon himself in 36 cases
- 6. Does not mean that the 160 acres doing the encroaching and the 160 acres being encroached upon have exactly the same ownership; but operator is the same and ownership is similar
- 7. Feel good about change in view of history since 1996

Second Change = Change 30-day notice to 20-day notice

1. 20-day notice is "standard" – no reason to be different here
