APPLICANT

Applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the SE/4 NE/4 of Section 9, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to form a standard 40-acre spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and or pools developed on 40 acres below the base of the Unitized Formation of the Maljamar Grayburg Unit to the top of the Abo formation, including but not necessarily limited to the Blinebry and Paddock members of the Yeso formation, West Maljamar Yeso Pool. Applicant plans to drill a vertical well at a standard location on these lands.
