

PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Case No. 14509: (Amended and readvertised)

Application of Cimarex Energy Co. for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Cimarex Energy Co. seeks an order approving a 320-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the S/2 of Section 15, Township 19 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests (i) from the surface to the top of the Bone Spring formation underlying the SE/4SE/4 and NE/4SE/4 of Section 15 to form standard 40 acre oil spacing and proration units, and (ii) the Bone Spring formation underlying the S/2 of Section 15 to form a non-standard 320 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area). The units are to be dedicated to (a) the East Lusk 15 Fed. Well No. 1, a horizontal well with a surface location in the SE/4SE/4, and a terminus in the SW/4SW/4, of Section 15, and (b) the East Lusk 15 Fed. Well No. 2, a horizontal well with a surface location in the NE/4SE/4, and a terminus in the NW/4SW/4, of Section 15. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Cimarex Energy Co. of Colorado as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells. The units are located approximately 32 miles west-northwest of Monument, New Mexico.
