CASE 13100: Application of Fruitland Coalbed Methane Study Committee to Amend Rules 4 and 7 of Special Rules and Regulations For the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool in Sections 17 and 18, T30N, R14W, and Portions of Sections 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 35, T30N, R15W, San Juan County, New Mexico.

CASE 13215: Application of Valles Caldera Trust to deny applications of GeoProducts of New Mexico, Inc. for permits to re-enter abandoned geothermal wells (APDs), Sandoval County, New Mexico. GeoProducts of New Mexico, Inc. has filed two applications for permits to re-enter geothermal wells (APDs) located on the Baca Grant No. 4 in Sandoval County, New Mexico. Applicant in this case, the Valles Caldera Trust, seeks an order of the Commission denying the referenced APDs. *The Application is set for hearing on preliminary legal issues only.* The wells that are the subject of the APDS are:

Baca Well No. 13, located 865 feet from the North line and 1565 feet from the East line (Unit B) of Section 12, Township 19 North, Range 3 East;

Baca Well No. 15, located 2035 feet from the North line and 85 feet from the East line (Unit H) of Section 11, Township 19 North, Range 3 East.
