IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY FOR A NON-STANDARD SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT AND COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

Mewbourne Oil Company, ("Mewbourne") through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat.Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978), for an order: (1) creating a non-standard spacing unit comprised of the W/2 SW/4 of Section 24 and the W/2 NW/4 of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico which will be a 160-acre horizontal well Project Area for its Wyatt Draw "24/25" LE Well No. 1H to be drilled from a surface location 2310 feet from the South line and 560 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 24 and then in a southerly direction in the Yeso formation to a terminus 2310 feet from the North line and 560 feet from the West line (Unit E) of said Section 25 and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Undesignated Yeso formation, in this non-standard spacing and proration unit, and in support of its application states:

- 1. Mewbourne is a working interest owner in the W/2 SW/4 of Section 24 and the W/2 NW/4 of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico and has the right to drill thereon. Mewbourne has an interest in each of the oil spacing units in this project area and therefore has standing to bring this application to pool all mineral interests therein in the Undesignated Yeso formation.
- 2. Mewbourne proposes to dedicate the above-referenced pooled project area to its Wyatt Draw "24/25" LE Well No. 1H to be drilled from a surface location 2310 feet from the South line and 560 feet from the West line (Unit L) of Section 24 and then in a southerly direction in the Bone Spring formation to a terminus 2310 feet from the North line and 560 feet from the West line (Unit E) of said Section 25.
- 3. Mewbourne has been unable to obtain a voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from Nearburg Exploration Company, LLC, 3300 North "A" Street, Building 2, Suite 120, Midland, Texas 79705 (Attention: Ken Dixon) the owner of a 10.3125% working interest in the W/2 SW/4 of the subject Section 24 and a 5.15625% working interest in the proposed project area.
- 4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

5. In order to permit the Mewbourne to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Mewbourne Oil Company should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on September 2, 2010 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

- A. creating a 160-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit in the Undesignated Yeso formation comprised of in the W/2 SW/4 of Section 24 and the W/2 NW/4 of Section 25, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, N.M.P.M.;
- B. pooling all mineral interests in this 160-acre non-standard unit / project area;
- C. designating Mewbourne Oil Company operator of this non-standard unit / project area and the well to be drilled thereon;
- D. authorizing Mewbourne Oil Company to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well;
- E. approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- F. imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Mewbourne Oil Company in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.
