IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY FOR A NON-STANDARD SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT AND COMPULSORY POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

APPLICATION

Mewbourne Oil Company, ("Mewbourne") through its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application to the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of N.M.Stat.Ann. § 70-2-17, (1978), for an order (1) creating a non-standard spacing unit comprised of the S/2 S/2 of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico which will be a 160-acre horizontal well project area and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, Santo Nino-Bone Spring Pool (Pool Code 54600) in this non-standard spacing and proration unit, and in support of its application states:

- 1. Mewbourne is a working interest owner in the S/2 S/2 of said Section 29 and has the right to drill thereon. Mewbourne has an interest in each of the 40-acre oil spacing units in this project area and therefore has standing to bring this pooling application.
- 2. Mewbourne proposes to dedicate the above-referenced pooled project area to its existing Bradley "29" Federal Com Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-37481) from a non-standard surface location 1050 feet from the South line and 1905 feet from the East line (Unit O) and then in a westerly direction approximately 3,050 feet in the Bone Spring formation to a terminus 972 feet from the South line and 343 feet from the West line (Unit M) of said Section 29.
- 3. The Bradley "29" Federal Com Well No. 1 was drilled pursuant to Oil Conservation Division Order No. R-13189 that was entered on November 2, 2009 which pooled these lands in formations developed on 320-acre spacing.
- 3. Mewbourne is unable to obtain a voluntary agreement for the development of these lands as a horizontal well nonstandard spacing unit / project area from the same working interest owners in the subject spacing unit that had to be pooled in the prior case. These owners are identified on Exhibit A to this application.

- 4. Said pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.
- 5. In order to permit the Mewbourne to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all mineral interests should be pooled, and Mewbourne Oil Company should be designated the operator of the well to be drilled.

WHEREFORE, MEWBOURNE OIL COMPANY requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on July 22, 2010 and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

- A. creating a 160-acre non-standard spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the S/2 S/2 of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, NMPM;
- B. pooling all mineral interests in this 160-acre non-standard unit / project area,
- C. designating Mewbourne Oil Company operator of this non-standard unit / project area and the well thereon;
- D. authorizing Mewbourne Oil Company to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the well;
- E. approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- F. imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Mewbourne Oil Company in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.

Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order (1) creating a 160-acre non-standard spacing unit comprised of the S/2 S/2 equivalent of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, and (2) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, Santo Nino Bone Spring Pool, in this non-standard spacing and proration unit which spacing unit will be pooled project area for the existing Bradley "29" Federal Com Well No. 1 (API No. 30-015-37481) that will be reentered at non-standard surface location 1050 feet from the South line and 1905 feet from the East line (Unit O) and then drilled in a westerly direction approximately 3,050 feet in the Bone Spring formation to a terminus 972 feet from the South line and 343 feet from the West line (Unit M) of said Section 29. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well and the allocation of the cost thereof as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Mewbourne Oil Company as operator of the well and a charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 8 miles south of Loco Hills, New Mexico.
