APPLICATION OF CIMAREX ENERGY CO. FOR A NON-STANDARD OIL SPACING AND PRORATION UNIT AND COMPULSORY POOLING, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

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Case No. 14582

APPLICATION

Cimarex Energy Co. applies for an order (i) approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E½E½ of Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and (ii) pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the non-standard unit, and in support thereof, states:

- 1. Applicant is an operator in the $E\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 23, and has the right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Applicant proposes to drill its Lynch 23 Fed. Well No. 2, to a depth sufficient to test the Bone Spring formation, and seeks to dedicate E½E½ of Section 23 to the well to form a non-standard 160.00 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for any formations and/or pools developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The well is a horizontal well, with a surface location in the NE¼NE¼, and a terminus in the SE¼SE¼, of Section 23.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in the $E\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 23 for the purposes set forth herein.
- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all mineral interest owners in the E½E½ of Section 23, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §§70-2-17, 18.

5. The approval of the non-standard unit and the pooling of all mineral interests underlying the $E\frac{1}{2}E\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 23 will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste,

and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its

order:

A. Approving a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone

Spring formation comprised of the E½E½ of Section 23;

B. Pooling all mineral interests in the E½E½ of Section 23 in the Bone Spring

formation;

C. Designating applicant as operator of the well;

D. Considering the cost of drilling and completing the well, and allocating the cost

among the well's working interest owners;

E. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together

with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and

F. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in

the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.

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PROPOSED ADVERTISEMENT

Application of Cimarex Energy Co. for approval of a non-standard oil spacing and proration unit and compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Cimarex Energy Co. seeks an order approving a 160-acre non-standard oil spacing and proration unit (project area) in the Bone Spring formation comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 23, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. Applicant further seeks the pooling of all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2E/2 of Section 23 to form a non-standard 160 acre oil spacing and proration unit (project area) for any pools or formations developed on 40 acre spacing within that vertical extent. The unit is to be dedicated to the Lynch 23 Fed. Well No. 2, a horizontal well to be drilled at a surface location in the NE/4NE/4, with a terminus in the SE/4SE/4, of Section 23. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well. The unit is located approximately 16 miles west-southwest of Monument, New Mexico.

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
