In accordance with Section 10 of the Poker Lake Unit Agreement dated March 18, 1952, BOPCO, L.P., Operator of the referenced unit, hereby submits a Plan of Development for the Poker Lake Unit for the year 2011.

HISTORY OF PAST DEVELOPMENT

We refer to our previous Plans of Development for a detailed description of the operations conducted in this Unit in prior years.

2010 ACTIVITY

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 293 1H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This well was drilled at a legal location being 810' FNL & 1,980' FEL, Section 21, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Delaware Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 293 2H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This well was drilled at a legal location being 810' FNL & 1,980' FEL, Section 21, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Delaware Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Well No. 302 H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> – This well will be drilled at a legal location being 2,200' FNL & 2,030' FEL, Section 28, T24S-R31E, Eddy County, New Mexico. This well was completed in the Delaware Formation.

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<u>Poker Lake Unit Big Sinks 27 Federal #1H Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This well will be drilled at a legal location being 215' FSL & 400' FEL Section 27, T24S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 13,739' to test the Bone Spring Formation.

<u>Poker Lake Unit Pierce Canyon 16 State 1-H, Eddy County, New Mexico</u> - This well will be drilled at a legal location being 175' FSL & 400' FEL Section 16, T25S-R30E, Eddy County, New Mexico to a proposed depth of 12,442' to test the Bone Spring Formation.
