FINDS THAT:

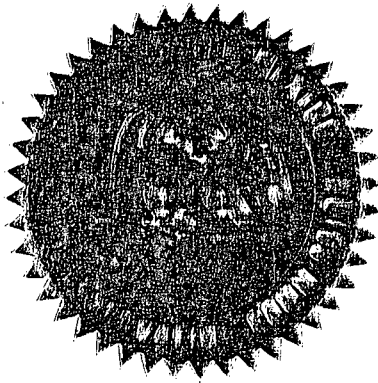
All matters in these cases are now moot.
