

Application of Mewbourne Oil Company for a non-standard spacing and proration unit, Re: unorthodox well location, and compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico.

Ladies and Gentlemen:

This letter is to advise you that Mewbourne Oil Company has filed the enclosed application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division seeking an order creating a non-standard spacing unit comprised of the W/2 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, NMPM; and pooling all mineral interests in the Yeso formation, North Seven Rivers-Glorieta-Yeso Pool, in this non-standard spacing and proration unit which spacing unit will be the project area for its proposed Wyatt Draw "13" ML No. 1H Well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location 250 feet from the North line and 350 feet from the West line of Section 24 and then in a northerly direction in the Yeso formation, to a bottom hole terminus at a location 2310 feet from the South line and 350 feet from the West line of Section 13, all in Township 19 South, Range 25 East.
