Applicant seeks an order canceling one drilling permit and reinstating another drilling permit, ordering operations halted on the well unit, and pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Mississippian formation underlying the W% of Section 12, Township 12 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, to form a standard 320-acre gas spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 320-acre spacing within that vertical extent, including the Undesignated Four Lakes-Morrow Gas Pool and Undesignated Four Lakes-Mississippian Gas Pool. The unit is to be dedicated to the existing State "X" Well No. 1, located at an orthodox well location in the SWXNW% of Section 12.
