At this time we will call Case Number 4 13,031, the Application of Mewbourne Oil Company for 5 compulsory pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. 6 7 Call for appearances. MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, Jim Bruce on behalf of 8 9 the Applicant. I just have a brief statement. I would also ask at this time you call the next 10 They involve the same section of land. 11 case. EXAMINER BROOKS: Very good, at this time we will 12 13 call Case Number 13,032, the Application of Mewbourne Oil 14 Company for compulsory pooling and an unorthodox oil well 15 location, Eddy County, New Mexico. Call for appearances. 16 MR. BRUCE: Mr. Examiner, again Jim Bruce 17 18 representing the Applicant. EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, any other appearances in 19 20 either of these cases? 21 Are you going to make a consolidated presentation of these two cases, Mr. Bruce? 22 23 MR. BRUCE: Yes, sir. 24 EXAMINER BROOKS: And are these presented under 25 Rule 1207.A?

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MR. BRUCE: A.(1).(b), I believe it is. 1 EXAMINER BROOKS: I haven't gotten as good with 2 those as I got with the Texas Rules of Civil Procedure. 3 Mr. Examiner, these two cases involve 4 MR. BRUCE: two wells, one in the east half of Section 11, 21 South, 27 5 East, the other one in the west half of the section. 6 These 7 cases have been filed under Rule 1207.A.(1).(b), and 8 attached to the Application were the land exhibits and 9 geologic exhibits. 10 I have handed you the notice affidavit regarding 11 notice given to the interest owners. The interest owners 12 pooled in each case are the same individuals that 13 collectively own, I think, less than a half a percent 14 working interest in the well. I would ask that the affidavit of notice be made 15 16 part of the record and that these cases be taken under advisement. 17 18 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, you've presented the 19 affidavit of notice to the reporter, I see. 20 MR. BRUCE: Yes, sir. 21 EXAMINER BROOKS: And the affidavit required by 22 Rule 1207 is attached to the Application? 23 MR. BRUCE: Yes, sir. 24 EXAMINER BROOKS: Now, in 13,032 it's advertised 25 as also being for an unorthodox oil well location. Can you

3	selected based upon the primary objective, which is the					
4	Morrow formation, and there were some surface obstacles at					
5	a standard location in the southwest quarter of the

It may not be explained in the MR. BRUCE: 1 affidavit, Mr. Examiner, but let me give you a little 2 background --3 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay. 4 MR. BRUCE: -- on that particular case. 5 This case was filed twice. It was filed once 6 7 last fall, and I'm looking for the case number. And we did 8 go to hearing at that time on this matter, and the reason 9 for the unorthodox location was explained in that hearing. Subsequently, all of the parties who were being 10 force-pooled in that case voluntarily joined in the well. 11 Then a subsequent title examination showed up a few 12 13 interest owners. It was a few limited partners of one of 14 the Coquina limited partnerships. 15 EXAMINER BROOKS: Right. MR. BRUCE: And they showed up after the fact, 16 and that's who -- Those are the four or five people being 17 force-pooled today. 18 19 That case number -- I can't find right now. It's 20 12,928. 21 EXAMINER BROOKS: Was an order entered in that case? 22 23 MR. BRUCE: There was -- I believe before an order was entered, the case was dismissed. 24 25 EXAMINER BROOKS: So the unorthodox --

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The reason for the --MR. BRUCE: 1 EXAMINER BROOKS: -- location has never been 2 3 proved then? MR. BRUCE: That's correct. 4 EXAMINER BROOKS: Either at hearing or 5 administratively? 6 MR. BRUCE: That's correct. 7 EXAMINER BROOKS: And is there -- It seems to me 8 9 we have to have some kind of evidence to grant an order. MR. BRUCE: If I could, Mr. Examiner, ask that 10 the -- There was testimony presented in 12,928. 11 If we 12 could incorporate that in the record of this case --13 EXAMINER BROOKS: Oh, okay. 14 MR. BRUCE: -- and the reason for the unorthodox 15 location was explained there. EXAMINER BROOKS: Very good, we will take 16 17 administrative notice of the record in Case Number 12,928. Is that the correct number, 12,928? 18 19 MR. BRUCE: Yes, sir. 20 EXAMINER BROOKS: Very good. We will take 21 administrative notice of the record in Case Number 12,928 22 in connection with Case Number 13,032. 23 Anything further, Mr. Bruce? 24 MR. BRUCE: No, sir. 25 EXAMINER BROOKS: Mr. Jones?

I noticed, Mr. Bruce, the well EXAMINER JONES: 1 location is based on the best location for the well in the 2 Morrow, which is the primary zone of interest. That's why 3 4 the oil turns out to be a little bit too far north? 5 MR. BRUCE: Yes, sir. EXAMINER JONES: And any affected parties to the 6 north have been noticed? 7 8 MR. BRUCE: They are all voluntary participants 9 in the well --10 EXAMINER JONES: Okay. MR. BRUCE: -- so they know what the location is. 11 12 And as far as the royalty owner goes, it's all state land. 13 So the royalty owner is not affected either. EXAMINER BROOKS: Are the pools identified in 14 15 the --MR. BRUCE: They are identified in the 16 17 Application. 18 EXAMINER BROOKS: Okay, very good.
