SUBJECT: Division Order R-10201

Dear Mr. LeMay:

According to the provisions of Division Order R-10201, the following special provisions are made for oil wells currently permitted for drilling by Mobil Exploration & Producing Texas & New Mexico Inc:

State O Well No. 3 located in Unit L of Section 33, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, consisting of a 40 acre proration unit, is assigned an allowable of 187 barrels of oil per day. In addition, a special testing allowable not to exceed 561 barrels of oil per day is assigned to the well, for a period of three months.

The State M Wells No. 16 located in Unit E and State M No. 17 located in Unit C, both in Section 34, Township 17 South, Range 35 East, each consisting of an 80 acre non-standard proration unit, is assigned an allowable of 374 barrels of oil per day. In addition, a special production test allowable not to exceed 1122 barrels of oil per day is assigned for a three month period.

Any over-production accrued during the testing period shall be made up within one year after the three month testing period.
