## CASE 11099: (Continued from September 15, 1994, Examiner Hearing.)

Application of TARA-JON Corporation for compulsory pooling, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant, in the above-styled cause, seeks an order pooling all mineral interests from the surface to the base of the Drinkard formation underlying the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 27, Township 16 South, Range 38 East, forming a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for any and all formations and/or pools developed on 40-acre spacing within said vertical extent, which presently includes but is not necessarily limited to the Undesignated Garrett-San Andres Pool, Undesignated Garrett-Drinkard Pool, and Undesignated East Garrett-Drinkard Pool. Said pooled unit is to be dedicated to <u>either</u> the plugged and abandoned The Texas Company Gotlieb Ertal Well No. 1 (T.D. - 13,310 feet), located at a standard oil well location 660 feet from the North line and 1982 feet from the West line, more or less, of said Section 27 <u>or</u>, if said Gotlieb Ertal Well No. 1 is found not to be mechanically sound, to a new well to be drilled at a standard oil well location thereon. Also to be considered will be the cost of re-entering and recompleting the old plugged and abandoned well and/or the costs of drilling and completing a new well and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as the operator of the unit and a charge for risk involved in re-entering the old plugged and abandoned well and/or the drilling of a new well. Said unit is located approximately 12 miles north of Hobbs, New Mexico.
