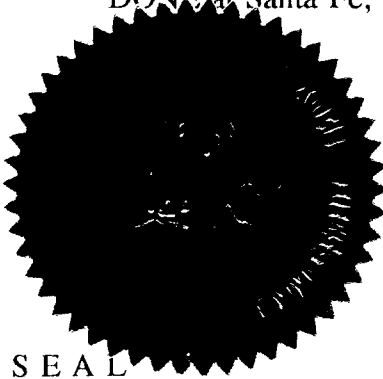
FINDS THAT:

- (1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) The applicant, Meridian Oil Inc., seeks approval to downhole commingle Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool (SW/4 dedication) with Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool production (S/2 dedication) within the wellbore of its Schumacher Well No. 3 located 990 feet from the South line and 1650 feet from the West line (Unit N) of Section 18, Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) At the time of the hearing, the applicant requested this case be dismissed.
- (4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case NO. 11120 is hereby dismissed.
